

## Addendum to Behaviour Policy May 2020

Sunningwell is preparing to welcome back children from the week beginning 1<sup>st</sup> June. Currently the government has advised that children should be cared for in 'bubbles'. This means that children will remain with the same group of children and staff members throughout the day avoiding mixing with other groups (bubbles).

There will be an expectation that children follow the instructions of the adults which will relate to where and when children can move around the school and also to those of Public Health England (children will be supported to understand these requirements) so that the potential spread of coronavirus is limited.

Where it is uncertain that children are unable to adhere to these instructions or where a child deliberately ignores them the following measure may be implemented;

- Staff may wear full personal protective equipment (PPE)
- Staff will inform the parents of the child that a breach in protocol has taken place and that the child must leave the school premises as soon as possible and not return until an assessment of whether the child can adhere to the instructions has been carried out.

In all cases the welfare of the children and the staff will be considered. If an unacceptable risk is identified a child may be asked to remain at home.
