

If My child has COVID-19 Symptoms?	<b>Your child must not come to school</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Email the school immediately</li> <li>Arrange for your child to be tested</li> <li>Inform the school via email of the test results</li> </ul>	Your child can return to school when the test is negative
My child tests positive for COVID-19	<b>Your child must not come to school</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Your child must self-isolate at home for at least 10 days</li> <li>Each household member should self-isolate for 14 days</li> <li>Inform the school via email of the test result</li> </ul>	Your child can return to school after 10 days as COVID symptoms can last for several weeks after the infection has gone.
Someone in the household has symptoms	<b>Your child must not to come to school</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Email the school immediately</li> <li>The person with symptoms must get a test</li> <li>Each household member should self-isolate for 14 days</li> <li>Inform the school of the test result</li> </ul>	Your child can return to school on completion of 14 days self-isolation OR the household member's test is negative.
Someone in the household has been advised to take a test	<b>Your child must not to come to school</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Email the school immediately</li> </ul>	Your child can return to school when the test is negative
Someone in the household has a positive COVID-19 result	<b>Your child must not to come to school</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Email the school immediately</li> <li>Each household member should self-isolate for 14 days</li> </ul>	Your child can return to school on completion of 14 days self-isolation
NHS Track and Trace has identified my child as in 'close contact' with COVID-19 symptoms/confirmed case	<b>Your child must not to come to school</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Email the school immediately</li> <li>Each household member should self-isolate for 14 days</li> </ul>	
NHS Track and Trace has identified someone in my household at 'close contact' with COVID-19 symptoms/confirmed case	<b>Your child may come to school if they don't develop symptoms</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The household member should self-isolate for 14 days</li> <li>Other members of the household do not need to self-isolate unless the original contact in the house develops symptoms (then all household members self-isolate for 14 days)</li> </ul>	Your child can come to school if they are not showing symptoms.
Returning from a destination where quarantine is required and has to self isolate?	<b>Your child must not come into school</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Inform the school via email</li> <li>Household must self-isolate for 14 days</li> </ul>	Your child can return to school on completion of 14 days self-isolation
