Dear Parents/Carers,

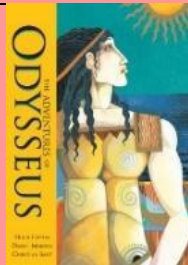
We hope you will find the following information helpful for this term.

LITERACY

All lessons are based on the 'Power of Reading', a scheme which promotes an enriched Literacy environment, where reading for pleasure is encouraged. A text is studied for a number of weeks, which increases the pupil's stamina in reading a book from start to finish. By studying in depth, a number of books each year, pupils will also build up a wealth of knowledge from a range of books, to draw upon in lessons.

Writing skills will be based around the following 'Power of Reading' texts:

'What We'll Build'
(Whole School)



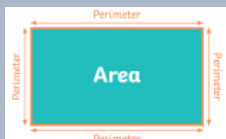
The written outcomes from these texts will display skills used across a variety of genres. Within lessons, there is a wide range of opportunities to develop skills in: reading, writing, speaking and listening, which link to the National Curriculum 2014.

MATHS

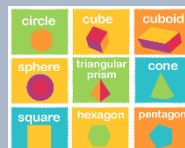
Lessons follow the 'White Rose Maths' scheme, which help builds a culture of deep understanding, confidence and competence in maths. We use 'Classroom Secrets' to give pupils differentiated questions to apply their learning. We also use 'Active Maths' which incorporates PE with Maths to support learning.

Maths learning will be based around these 'White Rose Maths' blocks:

Measurement: Perimeter, area and volume
Statistics



Geometry: Position and direction
Geometry: Properties of shape



Consolidation and themed projects



CREATIVE CURRICULUM

Pupils experience a whole school creative curriculum approach to learning. Pupils learn through two exciting themes each term on a two-year rolling programme to ensure they engage with a wide range of learning experiences and access the National Curriculum.

Home Learning:

Maths	Your child will be set a double-sided Maths sheet to complete each week for the following week.
Spellings	Your child will receive 10 spellings to learn each week which will be tested in school on a weekly basis.
Reading	Your child is encouraged to read every evening by themselves or with an adult at home. We are running a reading rocket competition across the school. Each time your child has read a book they need to record it on their bookmark and have it signed by an adult. On completion of 5 books they can hand their bookmark in to the teacher. Prizes will be awarded every half term.
There will be Literacy and Creative Curriculum home learning tasks to complete. These will be set depending when the learning goals are taught.
